DUNMORE EAST TENNIS CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT

The Dunmore East Tennis Courts are run and maintained by the Club Members. Court 1 and Court 2 are booked online, and can be booked from the hours of 7am to 9pm.

Booking a Tennis Court is all done online through our Website DETC.ie.

Members can book 2 days in advance throughout the whole year. Non Members can book the same from September to June. For the months of July and August, only 1 day in advance. Non Members Green Fee is €10 per court, per hour.

All Tennis Players, please **Lock the Gate** when you leave the court. When you are locking the gate, please scramble the code on the lock. This prevents soccer players from entering when courts are empty. When you book a court online, you get a confirmation email of your booking. This email also contains the code to the gate. We will change the code frequently. Please do not give this code to anyone.

Members booking per user, 2 at a time, 2 per day. Concurrent bookings (same time) not allowed. Consecutive bookings (adjacent times) not allowed.

IF YOU BOOK A COURT BUT CANNOT MAKE IT, CANCEL YOUR BOOKING. It is extremely easy to cancel a court online. If not cancelling your court becomes a habit with certain Members, we will charge a penalty, or put a stop to your booking online.

Booked Tournament times take precedent over all booked times.

Fair play is defined as a way of thinking, not just a way of behaving. Fair play is showing respect for other players. It is up to each individual player (junior or senior), to behave and act sportingly. We want to make sure that tennis is as enjoyable and successful for all who are involved.

- Runners are always to be worn on the courts.
- No hanging on the nets or climbing the fencing.
- No bad language to be used or bullying, on or around the courts.
- No Littering on or around the courts. Take your rubbish home or use a bin.
- No spitting on or around the courts.
- No Biking, No Skateboarding, No Scooters, No Soccer, No Rugby, No Hurling, No Dogs....Allowed on the courts at any time.

It is every Tennis Players responsibility to keep the courts litter free and damaged free. If you do see litter, please pick it up and throw it in the bin. If you do see people damaging the courts, stop them. If your require Garda assistance from the Local Garda ring the Garda Station 051 383112.
